

ORDINANCE NO. 07- 2017

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ELIZABETHTOWN, KENTUCKY
AMENDING CODE OF ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 133 RELATING TO
REQUIREMENTS FOR PUBLIC DISPLAY, SALE, POSSESSION, TRANSPORTATION
AND USE OF FIREWORKS AND PYROTECHNIC ARTICLES**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Elizabethtown, Kentucky, that from and after the passage, approval and publication of this ordinance that Chapter 133 of the Code of Ordinances relating to the requirements for public display, sale, possession, transportation and use of fireworks and pyrotechnic articles be amended as follows:

§ 133.07 DAYS AND HOURS FOR USING CONSUMER FIREWORKS.

[No person shall ignite fireworks between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.] Unless specifically permitted by the Elizabethtown Fire Department, persons may only use, ignite, fire or explode consumer fireworks on Memorial Day, July 3rd, July 4th, July 5th and Labor Day between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 a.m. (midnight) and December 31st between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 12:30 a.m. on January 1st. Any person wishing to use, ignite, fire or explode consumer fireworks any other day or time must notify the Elizabethtown Fire Department and receive express permission.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Mayor of the City of Elizabethtown and/or her designate be and he is hereby authorized and directed to take all steps necessary to perfect this ordinance.
