ORDINANCE NO. 18-2018

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ELIZABETHTOWN, KENTUCKY AMENDING ORDINANCE NO 24-2006 RELATING TO SMOKING IN PUBLIC PLACES AND PLACES OF EMPLOYMENT

WHEREAS, the Elizabethtown City Council desires to protect the health and safety of its residents, workers and visitors in the community; and

WHEREAS, the Elizabethtown City Council previously passed an ordinance to protect the health and safety of its residents, workers and visitors and wishes to clarify standards for the further protection of the public health.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Elizabethtown, Kentucky that from and after the passage, approval and publication of this ordinance that Ordinance No. 24-2006 be amended as follows:

Section 2. <u>Definitions</u>: The following words and phrases, whenever used in this Ordinance, shall be construed as defined in this Section:

M. "Smoking" means inhaling, exhaling, burning, or carrying any lighted <u>or heated</u> cigar, cigarette, pipe, or other lighted <u>or heated</u> tobacco <u>or plant</u> product <u>intended for inhalation, in any manner or in any form. "Smoking" also includes the use of an e-cigarette which creates a vapor, in any manner or in any form or the use of any oral smoking device for the purpose of <u>circumventing the prohibition of smoking in this Ordinance</u> [or any other lighted substance, whether otherwise legally possessed or consumed such as marijuana, in any manner or in any form].</u>

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Mayor or the City of Elizabethtown and/or her designate and she is hereby authorized and directed to take all steps necessary to perfect this ordinance.
